Key:

R = Residential - all residents have own room and are provided with meals and personal care. This category includes nursing homes, where there is also a degree of medical care.

SH = Sheltered Housing – residents have own flats and there is an on-site or on-call warden to take care of maintenance and to arrange activities in the communal lounge, which are sometimes open to non-residents.

ECH = Extra Care Housing – residents have own flats and can book care from an on-site domiciliary care team. There is usually a communal lounge, sometimes a café and activities are often open to non-residents.

C = Community – ie libraries/cafes/pubs etc.

DC = Day Centre – activities usually only open to those who attend the day centre.

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
